CHINESE EXECUTIVE ALLOWED TO APPROACH LOWER COURT AGAINST TRAVEL BAN

Decide Fast on Huawei CEO Plea: Delhi Trial Court

Take call preferably within 4 weeks, HC tells court; exec seeks quashing of I-T's look-out notice

New Delhi: The Delhi High Court has directed a report to be filed by the government "as expeditiously as possible" on a plea of Li Xiangwei, chief executive officer of Huawei Telecommunications (India), seeking quashing of a look-out circular issued against him by the income-tax department.

A look-out circular or LOC, prevents a person from travelling abroad. Authorities use it to prevent people accused in criminal cases from fleeing the country.

The trial court "shall consider the application for cancellation of the look-out circular as well as for particularisation of the grounds of the LOC" and the High Court held while granting Li the liberty to approach the trial court.

"In the event such an application is filed before the trial court within a week, the same shall be disposed of as expeditiously as possible, preferably within four weeks," it said in a ruling passed earlier this week.

Li's plea was disposed of after the court's advocate Vijay Aggarwal informed the High Court that Li would approach the trial court for cancellation of the look-out circular as well as permission to travel abroad. The High Court clarified that it has "not commented on the merits of the controversy" and that "the rights and contentions of all the parties are left open".

Li, a Chinese national, was stopped at New Delhi airport on May 1 and not allowed to board a flight to Bangkok to attend a meeting on behalf of Huawei Telecommunications (India). His boarding pass was cancelled and he was not returned to him. He had petitioned the Delhi HC challenging the LOC.

Li termed the I-T department's action as a "huge blow" to his reputation and "to the reputation of Huawei India". In response, I-T said Li "was a flight risk" and "did not wish to cooperate".

The department also alleged that his conduct had also demonstrated that "he did not wish to cooperate with the investigation". In February this year, a search operation was carried out by income tax sleuths at several premises linked to Huawei in India.

The department's affidavit alleged that the CEO had allegedly tried "to deny or mislead the bookend accounts, emails or key individuals of the company". It also alleged that Li "consistently denied and delayed the proceedings at hand search", even to the point of not providing access to the emails of the CEO of the company who remained outside of India.

The department argued that the "rights of an individual need to be balanced with safeguarding the interests of the prosecuting and investigating agencies". It told the Delhi High Court that a lower court has already taken cognisance of a complaint filed against Huawei, its CEO and others. And that the lower court has summoned the CEO and others.

The department said the LOC was issued after considering the actions of the CEO, which "led to a substantial belief that he wished to evade the investigation" being carried out against Huawei Telecommunications (India).

Li has denied accusations of non-cooperation. In a statement released to ET last Wednesday, the Chinese technology multinational's Indian unit said it is fully cooperating with the authorities and has submitted the requisite information and clarification as sought by the authorities from time to time.

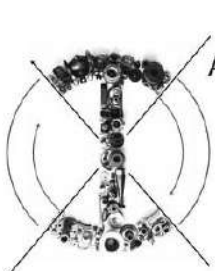

Honda to Discontinue 3 Models in India

New Delhi: Japanese carmaker Honda plans to discontinue its three models — Jazz, WR-V and fourth generation City — in India by March next year, according to industry sources. The company, which is present in the country through a wholly owned subsidiary Honda Cars India, will be left with only three models in its line up — City Hybrid, fifth generation City and entry-level sedan Amaze — after the discontinuation of the three models.

In December 2020, the company had stopped the production of Civic and CR-V with the closure of its Greater Noida plant as it struggled to strengthen its foothold in the Indian market. Sources close to the decision said the company is looking to re-focus on the company's core business of SUV models in the market.

When contacted over the issue, a Honda Cars India spokesperson said: "The company can not comment on the market speculations."

Earlier this year, the automaker had announced that it plans to launch an SUV in the country next year. The company is currently in the process of developing the model, it had stated.

In December 2020, Honda had announced the closure of manufacturing operations at its Greater Noida facility in Uttar Pradesh, thus consolidating its production activities at its second plant at Tapukara in Rajasthan.

The Japanese auto major had noted that the move has been taken to focus on manufacturing operations with the goal of improving business efficiency. —PTI

'Neobank Mkt to Rise 3x to \$11 B by FY25'

New Delhi: The country's neobanking market is expected to witness a three-fold jump to reach \$11.65 billion (about ₹92,000 crore) by FY25, reports said on Thursday (June 9). In the scale of the Indian market, there is a substantial opportunity for neobanking to create value for a large segment of customers while leveraging the large talent pool available to create high quality technology driven banking products. Grant Thornton has said in a report.

The neobanking market is well positioned to capitalise on the growing digital economy and achieve rapid growth due to the dynamic financial market with significant opportunities for the revenue generation potential, it said.

The Indian neobanking market was valued at \$1.42 billion of FY22 and is expected to grow at a three-year Compound Annual Growth Rate (CAGR) of 30.5% to reach \$11.65 billion by FY25.

Neobanks can be defined as branchless digital banks interacting directly with customers and providing a seamless banking experience. Neobanks are virtualised financial services providers delivering their complete suite of online offerings through digital channels or through strategic partnerships or creating their own products after approval from the concerned regulators.

Currently RBI neither recognises purely virtual banks nor regulates them. The report suggests that there is a regulatory clarity consistent with the global trend of digital banking and oversight. —PTI
