Athletes Face Ban for Violating Virus Rules in Tokyo

Athletes could be kicked out of the Tokyo Olympics if they violate virus rules including daily testing and wearing masks, officials said Tuesday as they unveiled updated guidelines just over five weeks before the opening ceremony. The latest and final version of the rules, which include 70 pages, complete with footnotes intended to explain the complex web of rules that organisers say will keep the Games safe. Officials hope the restrictions will build confidence among Japan's sceptical public that the games can be held safely even though the pandemic has not yet been brought under control. Olympic officials and Tokyo 2020 organisers emphasised new specific penalties for athletes who violate rules, including warnings, fines or even "temporary or permanent ineligibility or exclusion from the Games."

The Zeman Impact

How a Serie B coach laid down the foundation of the current Italy team

A 74-year-old chain-smoking Czech coach might have made just as much of an impact on Italy's squad as Roberto Mancini. Lazzaro Insigne and Marco Verratti each had breakout seasons under Zdenek Zeman in Serie B nearly a decade ago. 
