Athletes Face Ban for Violating Virus Rules in Tokyo

Athletes could be kicked out of the Tokyo Olympics if they violate virus rules, including daily testing and mask-wearing, organisers said Tuesday as they unveiled updated guidelines just over five weeks before the opening ceremony. The latest and final version of the rules for athletes runs 70 pages, complete with comic-strip infographics intended to explain the complex web of rules that organisers say will keep the Games safe. Officials hope the restrictions will build confidence among Japan's sceptical public that the Games can be held safely even though the pandemic has not yet been brought under control. Olympic officials and Tokyo 2020 organisers emphasised new specific penalties for athletes if they violate rules — including warnings, suspensions or even "temporary or permanent ineligibility or exclusion from the Games."

The Zeman Impact

How a Serie B coach laid down the foundation of the current Italy team

A 54-year-old chain-smoking Czech coach might have made just as much of an impression on Italy's squad as Roberto Mancini.

Ciro Inzaghi and Marco Verratti each had breakout seasons under Zeman in Serie B, but it was Zeman's tactical nous, where they learned an attacking philosophy that they're currently employing at the European Championship.

Italy's third goal in its 3-0 win over Turkey in the Euro 2020 tournament opener was a case in point, as Inzaghi hardly even looked when he slotted a pass between two defenders to set up Inzaghi for one of his preferred curled shots.

"I was reminded of how they understood each other on the field, how they can find each other with their eyes closed, how they speak the same language, how they move with and without the ball, which hope and believe to have helped each other," Zeman said. "The beauty of Inzaghi and Verratti is that they are a team, a team that can play in any formation, Zeman added in an emotional note in the Corriere dello Sport.

"They play together, one for another, they look for each other and find each other." Just like at Pescara in 2013-14, when Inzaghi scored 20 goals and missed the game against Turkey as he was injured for the last 16.

Many of those goals were set up by an 18-year-old midfielder named Verratti, who after helping Pescara win Serie B and gain promotion bypassed Serie A and went directly to Juventus. Zeman's powerhouse Paris Saint-Germain despite never being in a relegation battle in a top division.

Veratti's way back from a right knee injury. Veratti is expected to take a spot on Italy's bench for Wednesday's second Group A game against Switzerland.

Veratti showed that he was ready during a training match between Italy's reserves and Pescara's youth team on Saturday. He even wore a Pescara shirt for a portion of the scrimmage.

If Turkey ever draws against Wales or Portugal, Veratti could be a key player to watch in the group by beating Switzerland. At the very least, the Azzurri are hoping to secure a spot in the last 16.

Switzerland, meanwhile, needs points after drawing 1-1 with Wales in its opener. Switzerland coach Vladimir Petkovic faces a quandary in attack, with substitute Mario Gavranovic having performed better in the final minutes against Wales than the main players, Haris Seferovic and Granit Xhaka. One of them should line up alongside forward Granit Xhaka, who scored against Wales.

The game in Rome marks a homecoming of sorts for Petkovic, who led Lazio to a memorable win over Roma in an Italian Cup final at the Stadio Olimpico in 2013. Petkovic celebrated what remains his only title by taking hold of Lazio's mascot, a little eagle named Olimpia, and prancing around the stadium.

Who is to Blame for Spain's Scoring Problems?

Morata is being singled out but he isn't the only one who missed chances in 0-0 draw against Sweden

Spain's reserve players jumped from their seats in anticipation when Alvaro Morata scored himself, but only the goalkeeper to beat inside the Swedish area. A defender had whipped a cross into the box and the ball fell to Morata's feet with no one else near him. It was as clear a chance as any striker could have asked for, and Morata promptly tried to send a low, curling shot past the goalkeeper.

Spain coach Luis Enrique had already started to turn towards the bench to celebrate when he became aware that everyone else watching the match at Camp Nou Stadium was silent.

Morata's shot had missed just wide of the post. Just like that, lack of scor-

ing became an issue for Spain again. Morata's teammates also missed as Spain created chaos after chances, but couldn't get more than a 0-0 draw against Sweden in their Group E opener on Monday in Sevilla.

Spain had also been held scoreless in its warm-up match against Portugal, when it also had significant chances and couldn't get on the board.

Morata wasn't the only one missing chances against Sweden, but he was the one being singled out by Spanish fans and media.

Gonzalez said Tuesday, "Morata is feeling well. He is very strong and healthy. We know that he is a great player and that he can help us a lot. He knows that the goal will eventually come."

Morata initially had his name cheered by the crowd at La Cartuja,

old to be replaced by Pablo Sarriena in the 80th, although some did applaud Morata's effort.

Enrique raised his arms to his head in despair after Morata's big miss, as did most of the team members. But they were all behind him afterwards.

Spain had 17 total attempts, with five of them on target. Dani Oliva and Iker Muniain were among the players who also missed chances in front of the goal, as did substitute Gerard Moreno, the last chance being a header from a set piece in the 80th minute.

Luis Enrique will have a few days to decide whether he will stick with Morata in attack or give Moreno a chance from the start. Spain's next match is a group game in which it will face Sweden on Monday.

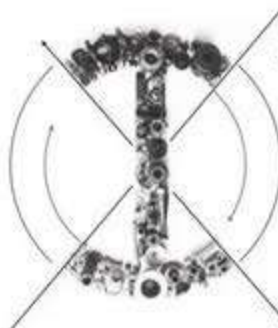
