Trai Rejects DoT's Plan to Bring Telemarketers Under its Control

Regulator flags complexities, limited outcome of any mechanism

New Delhi: Consumers are unlikely to get much of a respite from spam communications in the near future with the telecom regulator believed to have effectively rejected the Department of Telecommunications (DoT) request to bring telemarketers under a regulatory mechanism.

While Telecom Regulatory Authority of India's (Trai) current mechanism to curb spam communications puts the onus on telcos to check the menace, telemarketers who are at the heart of aggregating and disseminating commercial messages using teleo channels, are not under any regulatory ambit, and practically not accountable, said industry experts. Taking this into account, the DoT last year had asked Trai to recommend a mechanism to bring telemarketers under regulatory control and fix accountability — in line with the demand for telcos — as part of a concerted bid by authorities to curb pesky messages and calls.

Officials told ET that Trai has now replied to DoT highlighting the complexities around framing a regulatory mechanism for telemarketers, while also underlining that not much can be obtained by regulating them. "The regulator deliberated the matter at length before writing back to DoT to have a rethink at the mandate for regulating telemarketers. The DoT will examine Trai's reply and take a final call on the issue," one of the officials said, asking not to be identified. "The move, however, means continued bad news for consumers, who face pesky communications daily. Experts feel that once telemarketers are brought under some regulatory or authorisation framework, they can be held accountable for controlling spam along with telecom operators, and will be liable to face consequences."

Under the current Trai rules regarding commercial communications only telcos being held accountable. They do not cover telemarketers. The telcos say that since telemarketers send commercial communications from business entities, accountability should instead be fixed on them. Telcos said they are mere intermediaries and not the main players in the space.

Trai presently levies financial penalties on telcos for spam messages and calls on their networks. Telcos have commercial binding agreements with telemarketers and, as per Trai, operators should recover the penalty amount from telemarketers. But the system is not working

as telemarketers keep changing operators. Also, telcos can't enforce any conditions on them. Hence, carriers say they are getting penalised for cases where they don't have any control. Trai has been imposing fines on telcos — totalling about ₹141 crore so far — for their failure to curb spam. But operators have challenged the levy in the telecom tribunal, arguing that they should not be held accountable for something which they don't control or perpetuate.

A former Trai official said there are hundreds of telemarketers, and it is not possible to monitor them without the assistance of the telcos. "These unregistered tele-

marketers take telecom resources from the telcos only, whether it is PPA lines or SIM cards in bulk. So, it is the telcos only who know the details of such telemarketers. Thus, DoT/Trai has no other option, but to penalize the telcos for non-adherence to the regulations," Sudhir Gupta, a former Trai secretary, told ET. In India, 1.5-1.7 billion commercial messages are sent every day, taking the total to about 55 billion every month, according to industry data. As per data shared by telcos with Trai earlier, commercial traffic originates from about 290,000 business enterprises, which is then aggregated by about 10,000 aggregator telemarketers.

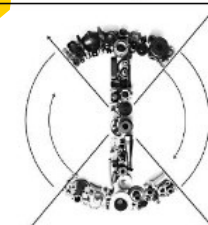

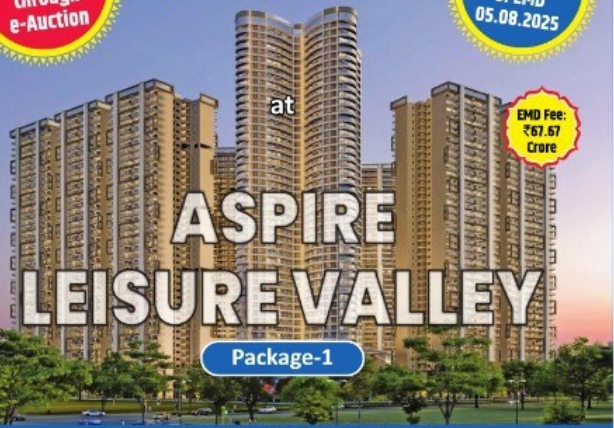
